The Barthel index is used to assess the degree of disability in an individual.

It records indicators of independence in terms of the disability caused by impairments. It gives a total score out of 100, relating to the physical aspects of disability.

Barthel Index Performance

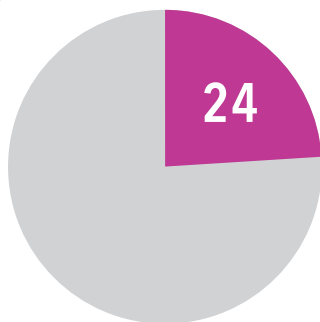

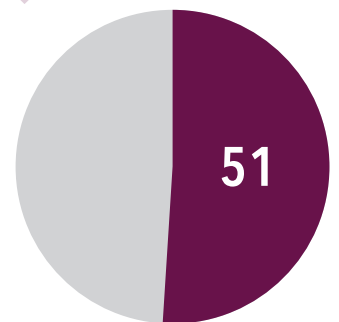

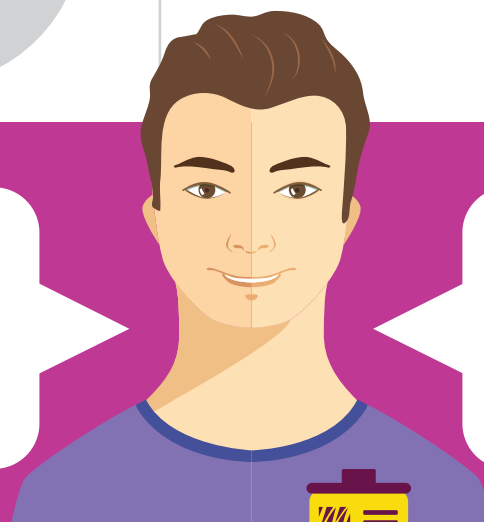


Average Score on Discharge
